

University Grants Commission (UGC) has introduced a Uniform Grading Scheme, for the preparation of results, to be followed by all the Public and Private universities in Bangladesh from the session 2006-2007.

| Numerical Grade | Letter Grade | | Grade Point |
|------------------------|---------------------|-------------|--------------------|
| 80% and above | A+ | (A Plus) | 4.0 |
| 75% to less than 80% | A | (A Regular) | 3.75 |
| 70% to less than 75% | A- | (A Minus) | 3.5 |
| 65% to less than 70% | B+ | (B Plus) | 3.25 |
| 60% to less than 65% | B | (B Regular) | 3.0 |
| 55% to less than 60% | B- | (B Minus) | 2.75 |
| 50% to less than 55% | C+ | (C Plus) | 2.5 |
| 45% to less than 50% | C | (C Regular) | 2.25 |
| 40% to less than 45% | D | | 2.0 |
| Less than 40% | F | | 0.0 |

However, Universities may use 'I' grade in case of incomplete grade and 'W' for withdrawn courses.

It is to be noted that, Institutions/Colleges, who are offering 'Pass' degree would still continue their old making system.
